The Project **-Creating Canopies-**

Greater Sydney Landcare through its partnership with Landcare NSW and the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) is planting trees with both public and private landowners across the Sydney basin. Over 63,000 trees have been planted on sites that include golf courses, hospitals, public reserves, small farms and habitat corridors.

The project plants mid story and tree canopy to expand natural corridors and link remnant patches of bushland in urban and peri-urban spaces. With a growing family of keen volunteers, the Greater Sydney Landcare Network is educating a new generation of tree planters and connecting them with their local Landcare and Bushcare groups.

Our Focus **-Building Resilience-**

Landcare in Sydney aims to improve 'resilience' for environments and people alike. The approach of urban ecologists within this project is to create urban green spaces that deliver cool refuges, welcoming habitats, colour, and biodiversity. Many of Sydney's remnant sites contain threatened plant communities - GSLN delivers the expertise needed with attention to species selection, design, and function within each site.
