Who we are

The ANPC is the national network that links people, research and action in plant conservation.

Our event

The biennial Australasian Plant Conservation Conference is the premier event in Australia to discuss native plant conservation issues.

Theme

With the overall theme “**Plant Conservation: Culture, Collaboration and Change**”, APCC15 will explore native plant recovery through rainforest restoration partnerships, collaborations with Traditional Owner groups, networks including the Queensland Threatened Plant Network (QTPN), managing impacts of a changing climate, recovering threatened plants and ecological communities, and managing biosecurity threats such as Myrtle Rust.

Audience

APCC15 will bring plant conservation scientists, practitioners, agency staff, students and volunteers together from across Australia to discuss the latest scientific findings and how best to approach the key threats to plant conservation in Australia.

Speakers

Invited speakers together with speakers selected from submitted abstracts will showcase their work through talks and posters, workshops will provide an opportunity for discussion, and field trips will allow attendees from across Australia to visit local sites of ecological interest. Social functions will encourage networking and collaboration (which are often considered a highlight of our conferences).
